Yet, all efforts were unsuccessful.

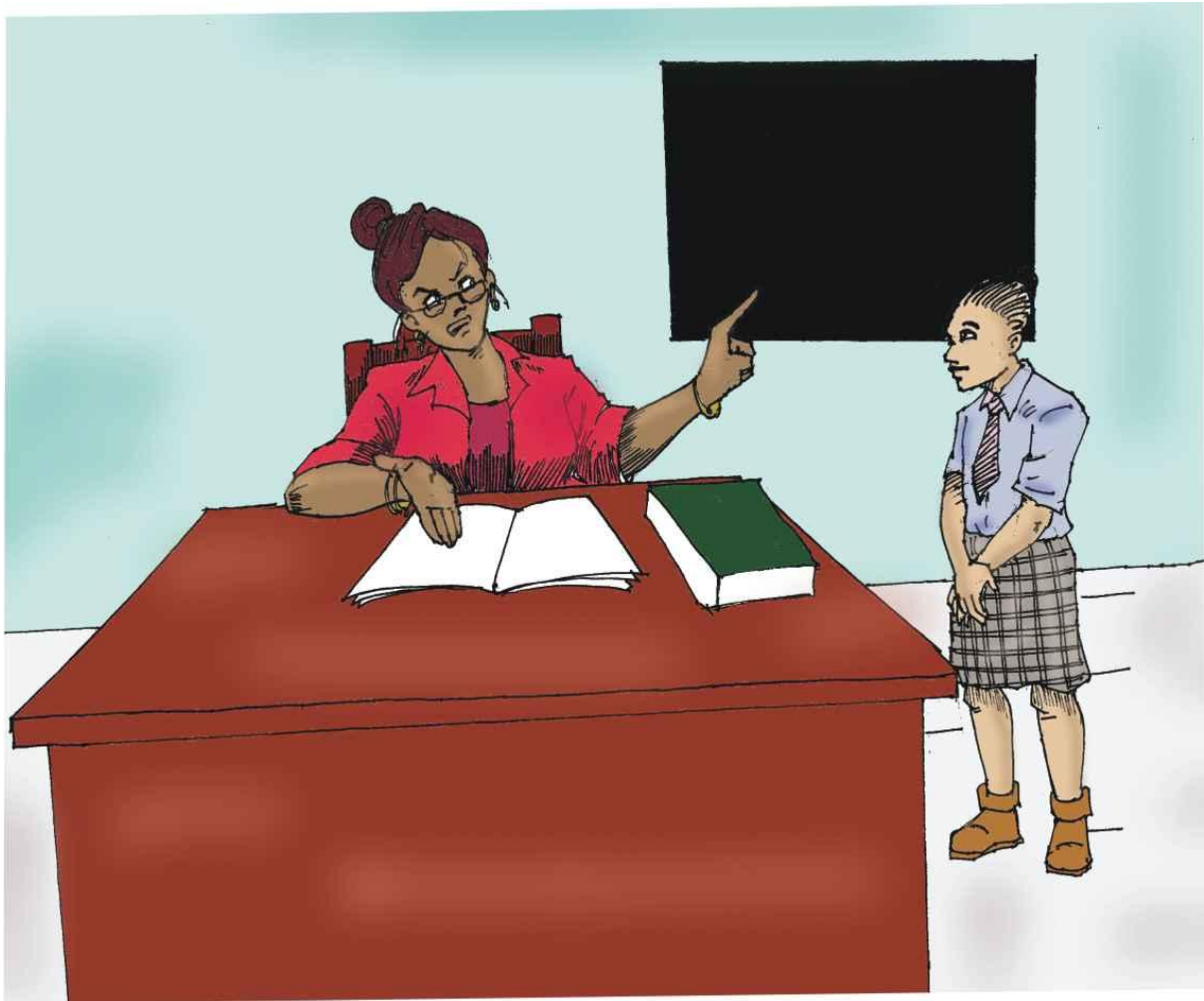
Amakwa Ada na ọ bụ onye na-adighi agụ akwụkwọ ya.

Maka na o woro ha anya na nke a ga-eme ka o mewe nke oma n'ihe gbasara ule nta na nke ukwu.

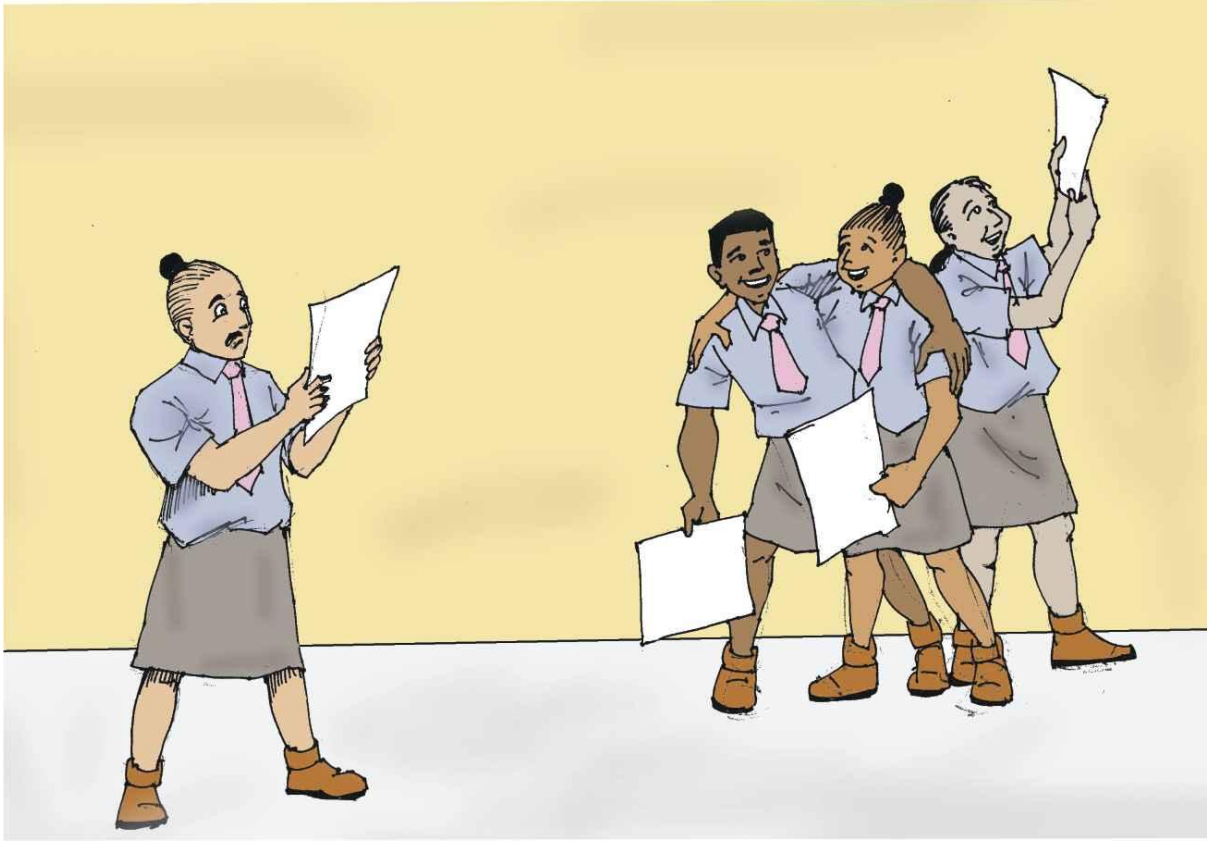
For they all knew that this would make her performance in tests and examinations improve rapidly.

he hardly eats, when he gets home.

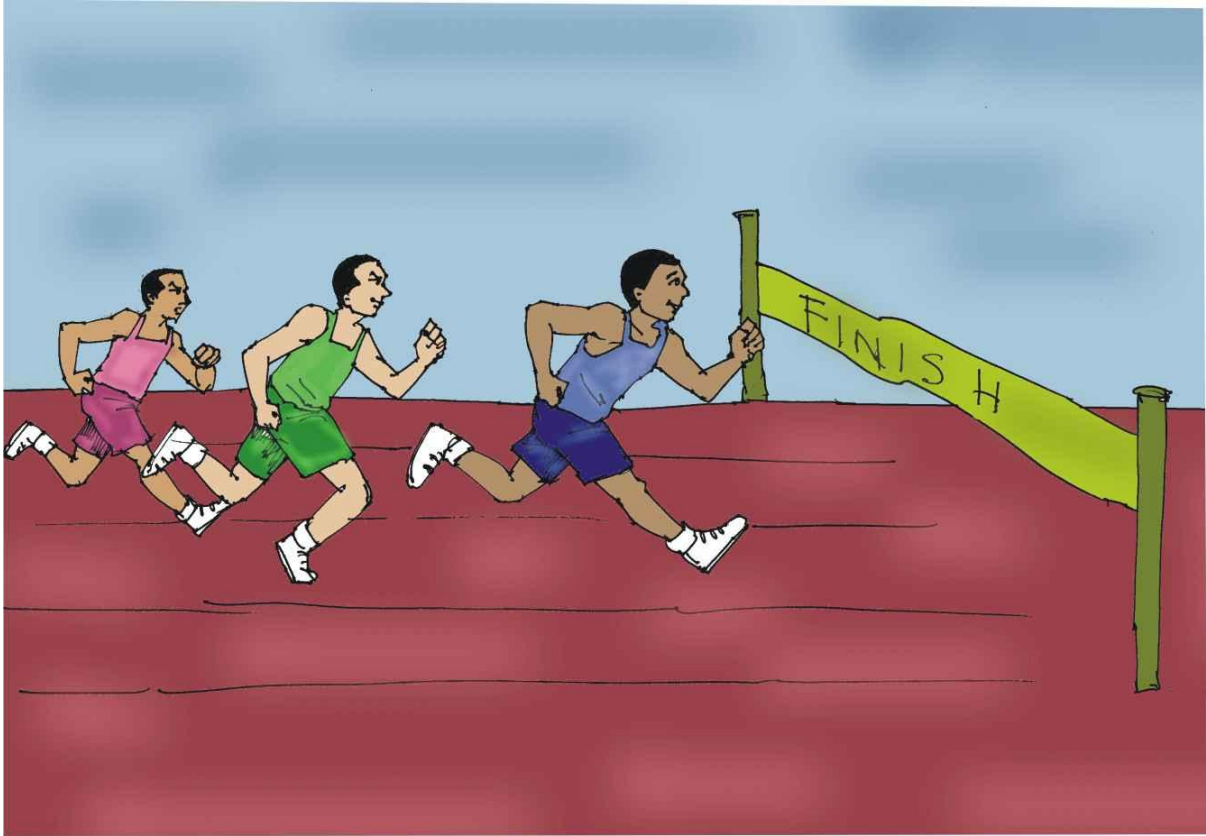


A b̄iakwa n'egwuregwu agbam ọsọ,

Obi is also smart.

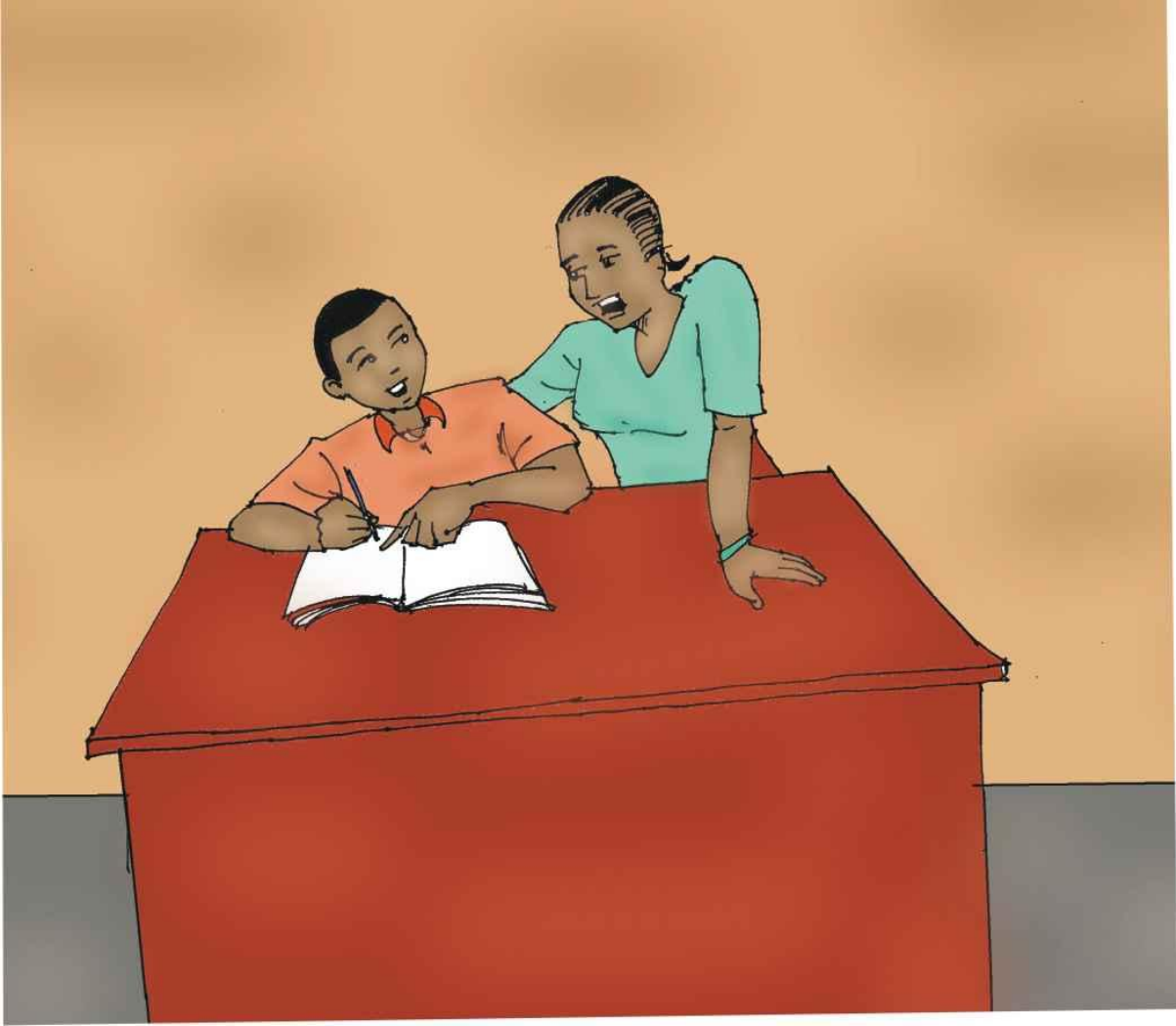
Ihe ọ bụla ọ na-aghọtaghị,

Ya mere o ji ekpe ekpere n'ututu, ehihie, abali n'oge o bua o choro iri nri.

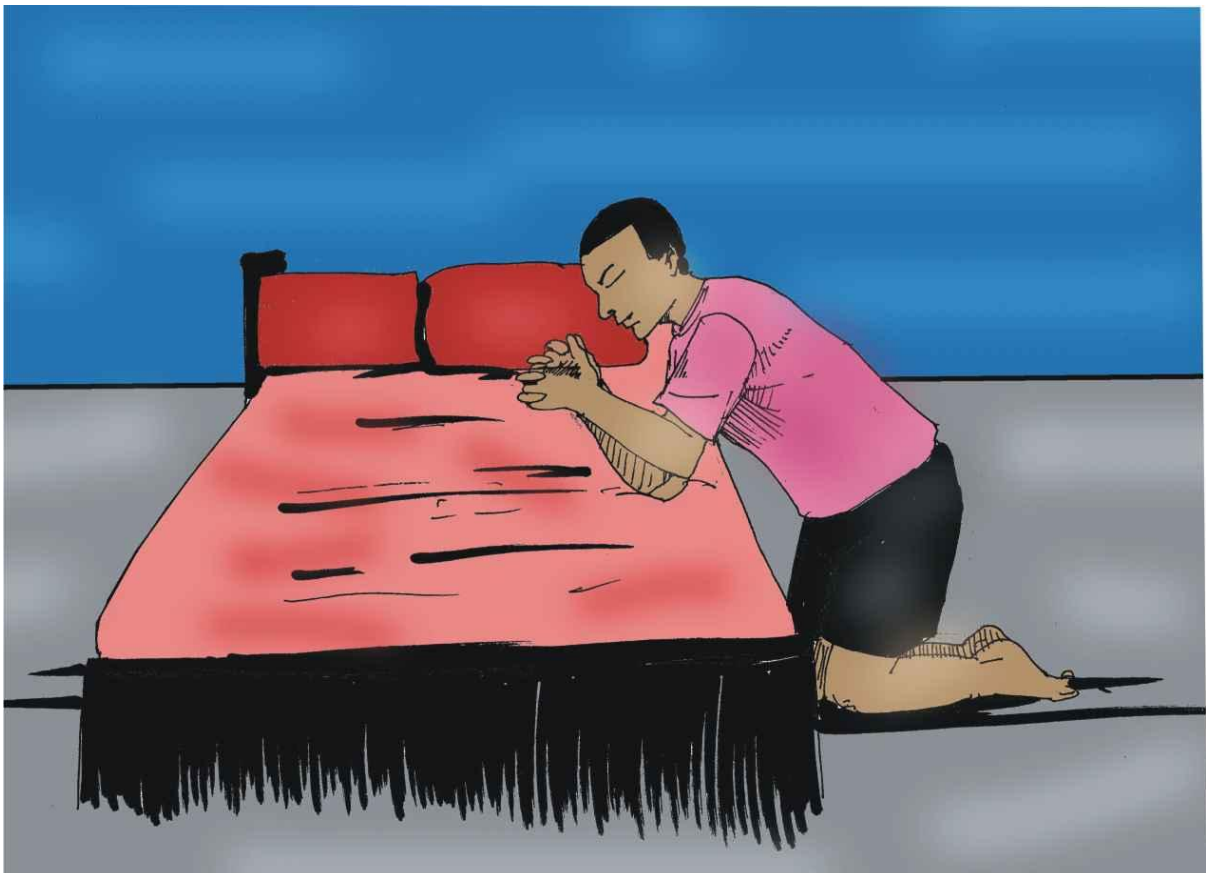
That's why he prays morning, afternoon, night, and any time he wants to eat.
